

Hoodoo's Dress Code and Appearance Policy

How Do You Appear? Do You Have Personal Pride?

Employee appearance is one of the first and most lasting impressions our guests have of Hoodoo. A clean neat appearance indicates personal pride and a professional attitude.

Are you in proper uniform, including a nametag?

Is there a smile on your face?

We respect your right of individual expression, but many guests are traditional about grooming and fashion and we needn't attract undue personal notice while we provide our services. If you are not conforming to the grooming guidelines, you will be asked to make the necessary changes.

Employees will be inspected by the department manager before each scheduled shift for compliance.

For All Staff Members:

Hair: must be clean, neat and well groomed. For some positions, longer hair (from just above shoulder length) must always be pulled back or tucked into a uniform hat for safety and health reasons. Employees working at Hoodoo must wear their hair in a conventional style, cut and color. Unnaturally colored hair or shaved portions are not acceptable.

Dreadlocks are not considered conventional for purposes of our grooming policy.

They MUST BE covered at all times while in uniform, during your work shift, on company time or in any department work area.

Beards: Well-established beards and mustaches are allowed if they are neat, clean and trimmed. Growth may not be started at any time during the ski season and beard length is limited to 2 inches.

Attire and Uniforms: must be neat, clean, well kept (not frayed, no holes or patches) and appropriate for the job, including shoes and boots. While on duty you will be in uniform, if provided. For a nominal cash fee you can request to have uniforms laundered through Hoodoo. Please ask your department manager for details.

Daily Hygiene: as an employee in contact with the public (inside or outside position) you must bathe frequently. Use of soap, deodorant, antiperspirant and toothpaste is a must.

Body tattoos, if visible to the public, must be inconspicuous. The image and/or words cannot be such that it would be considered offensive to our guests.

Facial Jewelry is not allowed (eyebrow / lip / etc). However a plug may be inserted if the pierced area is visible to the public. Hoodoo reserves the right to be the final judge on acceptability.

For Men: Two Earrings, studs or hoops up to 1/2" diameter, are acceptable.

For Women: A maximum of three earrings in each ear is acceptable.

Although we respect your personal style and taste, our duty to our guests requires that management be the final judge of employee appearance.

Wearing other Companies Logoed Clothing while on duty: Conspicuous corporate logos or advertising is not acceptable.

Off-duty employee uniform policy - from the ski area - should not wear uniforms at any time, including at another resort. Uniforms should not be worn while skiing or boarding. Wearing your uniform while on a ride break violates company policy and is grounds for dismissal.
